    - Naturopathic Manipulation Exam (practical)
    - Acupuncture Exam (practical)
    - Physical Diagnostic Skills Exam (practical)
- \_\_\_\_ **Two letters of reference** regarding your character, how long the references have known you, and in what capacity they know you. References must be:
  - 1. A Naturopathic Doctor

- 2. Any one of the following:
  - Police officer
  - Medical doctor/Dentist/Optometrist
  - Chiropractor
  - Member of Clergy
  - Mayor or Councillor
  - Member of Parliament or provincial Legislature
