REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFERRING MEMBERSHIP FROM ANOTHER **JURISDICTION**

In order to process your application for registration, the SANP must receive the following:
 Application Form Registration fee If an applicant is applying from a <i>regulated</i> province: A letter from the Canadian licensing body from which the applicant is transferring from. This letter must state that the applicant is in good-standing with that licensing body AND that there are no complaints or investigations currently against the applicant.
<u>OR</u>
If an applicant is applying from an <i>unregulated</i> province: Copies of the following must be received <u>directly</u> from the licensing body:
 NABNE Transcripts for NPLEX Parts I and II Transcripts confirming your graduation from a CNME accredited Doctor of Naturopathic Medicine program Confirmation from the Jurisdiction that he/she has completed: Naturopathic Manipulation Exam (practical) Acupuncture Exam (practical) Physical Diagnostic Skills Exam (practical) Two letters of reference regarding your character, how long the references have known you, and in what capacity they know you. References must be: A Naturopathic Doctor AND Any one of the following: Police officer Medical doctor/Dentist/Optometrist Chiropractor Member of Clergy Mayor or Councilor Member of Parliament or provincial Legislature
Criminal Record Check (Available from the RCMP or local police department) – A copy can be sent directly from the licensing body, or an ORIGINAL must be sent by the applicant if the licensing body does not have an original copy. CPR, AMLS, or ACLS certificate – please send a photocopy of the
Certificate Liability insurance – please send a photocopy of the confirmation letter/document
