## Non-registered Grads

Adopted May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010

Registrants Working With Non-Registered Naturopathic College Graduates

The SANP **does not** recommend that registered naturopathic doctors work with nonregistered graduates of approved naturopathic colleges for patient care. However if they choose to do so, the Board mandates that the Registrants ensure these criteria be followed:

- 1. the Board is informed in writing by the Registrant that the graduate is working under the Registrant's registration in any capacity providing patient care;
- 2. the graduate obtain a **Temporary** membership with the SANP;
- 3. the Registrant accepts sole responsibility for the non-registered graduate in their employ;
- 4. the Registrant have malpractice insurance in place that will cover persons in their employ;
- 5. the graduate does not use the N.D. designation until registered with the SANP;
- 6. the graduate be actively working towards registration;
- 7. patients are informed that a non-registrant will be working with them under the supervision of the Registrant; an 8\_"x 11" written notice is to be displayed prominently using the wording as per Schedule A attached; signed prior consent is obtained from the patient indicating that the non-registrant is involved in providing their health care;
- 8. any suggested diagnosis, or possible treatment plan must be discussed, approved and signed by the Registrant **before** being communicated to the patient;
- 9. only Registrants perform the following:
  - a. internal examinations and breast examinations;
  - b. procedures on tissues below the dermis for the purpose of venipuncture, skin-pricking, needle acupuncture, removal of foreign bodies from the superficial structures and the treatment of minor cuts and abrasions;
  - c. moving the joints of the spine beyond the individual's usual physiological range of motion using a fast, low amplitude thrust;
  - d. administration by injection or inhalation a substance consistent with naturopathic practice;
  - e. application of a form of energy;
  - f. allergy challenge testing of a kind in which a positive result of the test is a "significant allergic response."
- 10. the Registrant is present or on location at all times while patients are being seen by the non-Registrant.
