Injection Therapy -
Adopted March 13, 2013

For the purpose of this policy, injection therapy refers to the administration of injectable nutrients administered through intramuscular and/or subcutaneous routes to supplement and support health.

TREATMENT OF PATIENTS USING INJECTION THERAPY

The naturopathic practitioner must perform injection therapy as they have been trained in their Naturopathic College.

It is highly recommended that the Naturopathic doctor follow the same safety and Emergency preparedness procedures as outlined in the Intravenous Policy.

The following substances are approved for use in Injection Therapy. (The use of substances not included in this list is not permitted unless the member is certified to do so by the SANP under a separate policy).
